### Expertise

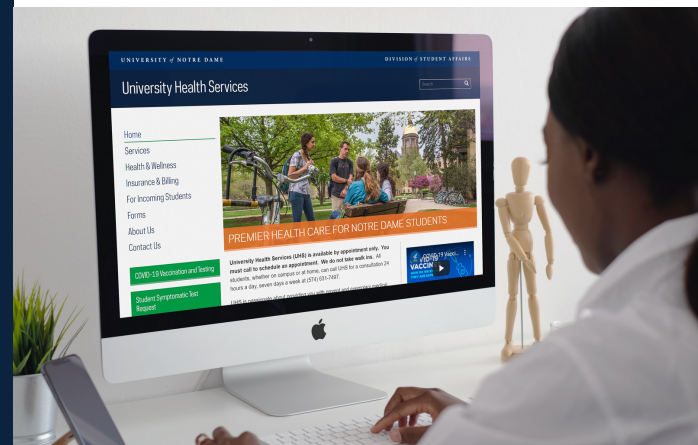
Our exceptional providers and nurses administer unparalleled care. UHS continues to be accredited by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHCC)

## Provider Appointments

Call (574) 631-7497 to schedule an appointment. Appointments are required, we do not see walk-in's. UHS provides allergy treatments, travel health consultations, women's health exams, and wellness visits. Students also have access to free, 24/7 telehealth provided by TimelyCare. TimelyCare provides virtual access to licensed providers for medical and mental health needs. ## Urgent Care

For urgent medical needs, students can call UHS to make an appointment and be evaluated by a nurse and will be referred to the most appropriate level of care. Appointments are required.



## Insurance & Billing

We understand that insurance and billing can be difficult to navigate. We're here to help. Student tuition supports UHS, so there is no charge for office visits. We also charge less than industry standards for things like medicines (such as vaccines), durable supplies, (like immobilizer boots for ankle injuries), and procedures (like x-rays or suturing).

## Walgreens Pharmacy

The UHS pharmacy is managed by Walgreens, offering students the convenience of a national pharmacy on campus.

## Laboratory

Many medical tests are performed on site at UHS. Additional testing is offered by LabCorp, which provides laboratory services on campus for students with a provider's order.



## X-Ray

Radiology service at UHS provides an immediate diagnostic tool for timely evaluation and treatment.

## Physical Therapy

The McDonald Physical Therapy and Sports Rehab Center at UHS can help students maximize movement and minimize pain. An expert team provides services that include manipulation, massage, electric stimulation, cold packs, and teaching students new exercises.

## Clinical Case Managers

UHS has two Clinical Case Managers. One is a registered nurse who can work with students with complex chronic and/or acute medical conditions and coordinate the care needed to assist them in maintaining independence. Another is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker who can coordinate and support mental health care within the clinic by providing a broad range of psychological and mental health services to students.



## Immunizations & Allergies

Whether students need regular allergy injection therapy, a vaccination to meet Notre Dame's requirements, or an immunization before studying abroad, we've got you covered.

## Travel Consultation

Come see us before you leave the country. Pre-travel health counseling is essential to ensure a safe and healthy vacation or study abroad experience. Schedule your appointment at least two months prior to your trip.
