Common Symptoms	Runny nose, mild cough caused by postnasal drip	Fever, chills, muscle aches, fatigue	Fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell
Uncommon Symptoms	Fever, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing	Shortness of breath, difficulty breathing	Sneezing, runny nose, sinus congestion
Onset	Gradual, within 1-3 days	Sudden, within 2-4 days	Within 2-14 days

While there are some similarities, remember the one difference: There's a vaccine for the flu.

Students are required to be vaccinated for the flu this fall. Students may receive a free vaccine by scheduling an appointment at one of two Flu Vaccine Blitzes or go off campus to receive their flu vaccine through a local primary care provider, pharmacy, or walk-in clinic. If going off campus, students should refer to their individual insurance plans for pricing. Students not receiving the flu vaccine through the University must provide documentation about receiving the vaccine via their UHS Patient Portal.

Students must receive the flu vaccine by Monday, Nov. 2.
